Puppet Open Source

License

- 2005: GPL
- 2011: (Puppet 2.7) Apache 2.0 (Puppet Enterprise)
- 2025: Proprietary Software (Closed Source)

Owner

- Reductive Labs -> Puppet Labs -> Puppet
- Perforce (since 2022)





2013: founded (puppet-community)


- collaboration on Puppet module development
- unified pipelines and code synchronisation (module_sync)
- events

2015: renaming to Vox Pupuli (legal reasons)

Actual: 217 maintainers for 335 repositories (1st July 2025)











- collaboration on Puppet Module development
- development of test frameworks (Lint, RSpec-Puppet) and plugins
- collaboration on PuppetLabs Modules

When Luke Kanies was pushed off, problems started:

- now answers or slow responses

Since Perforce acquired Puppet, things got worse:

- blocking community admins from Puppet-Community Slack

Puppet EULA(s)

User EULA (https://forge.puppet.com/eula)

- max 25 Nodes
 - 3.1: Each Managed Node in excess of twenty-five (25) requires the purchase of one subscription license for the applicable Software.
- no error analysis
 - 2.2: Customer shall not: (i) reverse engineer or otherwise attempt to discover the source code or human readable data or underlying ideas or algorithms of the Software
- no support
 - 4.1: The Software does not come with a standard support services package for the Software

Puppet EULA(s)

Developer EULA

(<u>https://www.perforce.com/system/files/2025-02/Puppet-Core-Developer-Program-License-Agreement.pdf</u>) - same as User EULA

- no Public CI Pipelines
 - 2.2 Developer may not use the Software other than for (i) publication to the Puppet forge, or (ii) for the Developer's customer's use only
- Modul publication on Puppet Forge or on GitHub
 - 2.4 modules are created for (i) publication to the Puppet forge, or (ii) for the Developer's customer's use only

Puppet Registered Trademark

End 2024:

- Perforce Legal: the term "Puppet" must be removed!
- Community asks: also "lib/puppet"?


2025:

- Perforce says: Packages may not have the name Puppet
- "lib/puppet" is an API and OK to continue to use
- "puppet" CLI is OK maybe (similar to MariaDB)








Reactions of the Community





End 2024:

- ~50 Community developer met
- Overlook Infratech (Ex-Puppet) explains their plans
- many former Puppet developer and community members can and want to support
- Universities say: "We have developers, we only need the issues, but we don't do the planning."
- Voxpupuli Sponsoring

Community determines, that it is possible to continue development!

2025 Q2:

- Clone all public PuppetLabs GitHub repositories to https://github.com/openvoxproject
- Public Pipelines for packages Rebuild
- Renaming from Puppet to OpenVox (package names)
- Remove puppetlabs_spec_helper from CI pipelines (28. May 2025)
- OpenVox Ruby Gem (30. May 2025)
- Ruby 3.4 and JRuby 10 (WIP)





2025 Q2:

- Fork of facter (OpenFact)
- Fork of Bolt (OpenBolt)

2025 (in planning):

- Rename CLI from puppet to openvox
- Compat package (symlinks puppet -> openvox)
- Removal of unmaintained libraries
- Switching all Vox Pupuli tests to new gems






2025 (Planning):

OpenVox is Puppet

Drop-in replacement

- same paths, identical config, same CLI
- New OS support:
 - Ubuntu 18 24
 - Debian 10 13
 - EL 7 10
 - Fedora 36 42
 - SLES 15
 - Mac OS 15 (atm arm64 only)
 - Windows 64bit
